Provenance for Myrmecodia species from Sarawak

I received seeds of this material from a friend in Australia on May 18, 2010. The seeds were taken off a plant that he was given. The plant was said to have been from the Malaysian State of Sarawak on the Island of Borneo

Given an origin in Sarawak these plants will probably be either Myrmecodia tuberosa 'bracteata' or Myrmecodia tuberosa 'apoensis'. We will need these seedlings to mature and produce flowers and fruits before an identification can be made.

Here is a photo of the plant I will be sending you. It was sown on October 1, 2017 and is currently growing in a 2-1/2 inch pot.
